Requirements for Compliance with COVID-19 Procedures:

- All program participants must meet [WAS General Essential Eligibility Criteria](#), or have contacted WAS regarding reasonable adaptation.
- Student and any support person(s) remaining on-site for the duration of the program must consent to symptom screening measures.
- Student and support person(s) must verify independently or with the assistance of a companion:
 - Student and support person(s) do not have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, or 96 degrees or lower.
 - Student and support person(s) have not experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days.
 - Student and support person(s) have not had close contact with anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Student and any support person(s) remaining on-site for the duration of the program must wear a mask that has at least two layers of fabric, covers the nose and mouth, and is secured below the chin at all times, including but not limited to, any time spent in the prep area, within 6 feet of other individuals, and throughout the lesson experience.
 - Students who are not able to wear a mask for medical or sensory reasons should contact WAS to discuss participation with reasonable adaptation.
- Students are permitted to lower their mask away from their airway **ONLY** while actively riding one-on-one with an instructor at a distance of at least 6 feet apart. The student must be able to independently manage their mask and pull it up over their nose and mouth any time they are within 6 feet of other individuals and upon re-entering the prep area.
- Student and support person(s) must maintain a minimum of 6 feet distance from others at all times and must sanitize hands often throughout the lesson.
- Any student requiring physical assistance (e.g. transfers, lesson preparation, hand-over-hand guidance) must bring a support person with them.
 - For students who are not able to participate due to lack of access to a support person, WAS staff will evaluate on an individual basis whether WAS can safely provide assistance for their participation.
- Students who cannot comply with these requirements will be asked to wait to participate until they are able to do so, or until requirements for participation are such that they can comply.
- WAS requires all employees, instructors, and volunteers (volunteers engaged in the direct support of instruction) to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19.
