WAS Volunteer Requirements for Compliance with COVID-19 Procedures:

- All WAS Volunteers must complete required registration and release, sign the sport protection handbook, complete background check, and attend volunteer training prior to volunteering at programs.
- WAS requires all employees, instructors, and volunteers (volunteers engaged in the direct support of instruction) to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19.
 - Vaccinations received must be fully approved by the FDA or granted Emergency Use Authorization in the US; individuals must remain current with boosters per CDC guidelines.
 - Fully vaccinated is defined as 2 weeks after the second dose of a 2-dose series (e.g. Pfizer/Moderna), or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine (e.g. Johnson & Johnson).
 - Any volunteer who is assisting at programs must be fully vaccinated prior to their first volunteer shift.
 - All volunteers must submit a vaccination attestation form and show proof of vaccination to WAS program director or program coordinators. Vaccination records will not be stored by WAS. Acceptable proof of vaccination may include:
 - COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card or photo of the card.
 - Documentation of vaccination from a health care provider or electronic health record.
 - State immunization information system record.
 - A volunteer who does not provide proof of vaccination will be asked not to volunteer at this time.
- Volunteers remaining on-site for the duration of the program must consent to symptom screening measures.
- Volunteers must verify independently or with the assistance of a companion:
 - Student and support person(s) do not have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, or 96 degrees or lower.
 - Student and support person(s) have not experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days.
 - Student and support person(s) have not had close contact with anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Volunteers remaining on-site for the duration of the program must wear a mask that has at least two layers of fabric, covers the nose and mouth, and is secured below the chin at all times, including but not limited to, any time spent in the prep area, within 6 feet of other individuals, and throughout the lesson experience.
